

Producer Fact Sheet March 2024



(2021 Ribolla Gialla Pettarin) "There can be no doubt that Miani's Ribolla Gialla Pettarin is not just the best Ribolla Gialla wine made in Italy, but an argument can be made that it may well be Italy's best white wine, period.. Luminous pale golden-tinged yellow. Complex, deep and still very youthful aromas and flavours of yellow fruit, lime curd, almond paste, jasmine and lemon verbena, complemented by delicate but captivating notes of saffron and acacia honey. Vibrant and penetrating, this beautiful wine finishes long and clean with rising mineral and white flower nuances, and a strong hint of lemon and lime. Compellingly well-balanced, this very young Ribolla Gialla has the glyceral texture typical of his ultraconcentrated wines but is still an infant: though it's great to drink right now, this superfocused, super-energetic wine will be a far better, more complete wine with another five years or so of bottle age." 96+ points, Ian D'Agata, Terroir Sense (February 2024)

MIANI

Friuli Venezia-Giulia, Italy

Miani's Enzo Pontoni is one of the best producers of white wines in Italy. His white (and red) wines have become absolute cult wines owing to a remarkable depth of flavour and concentrated texture, though they are never heavy or unbalanced.

In the Colli Orientali DOC, Miani sits on a hilly slice of the Udine province near Italy's border with Slovenia. On a total of 13 hectares (4 are family owned), they cultivate Chardonnay, Sauvignon, Malvasia, and Friulano, as well as, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Refosco dal Peduncolo Rosso. The vineyards are situated at an altitude from 100 to 300 meters above sea level, and the vine density is kept relatively low at 3000 plants per hectare. In the winter the vines are mercilessly pruned and the drastic green harvest leaves one or two bunches per vine. It is clear that revenue and profitability have never entered this winemaker's agenda, while the manicured vineyards show intense passion for viticulture.

Enzo took over the family winemaking business after his father had passed away. Leaving his engineering career in order to dedicate himself fully to his new passion. At almost 7 feet tall, Enzo has a commanding presence and does not compromise when it comes to making wine: each year he only produces 9000 bottles, and all according to rigorous organic farming methods. He ages many of his wines in French oak barriques, and does not interfere with the natural temperature of fermentation.

His reds are complex and decadent, and his white wines are, for many experts, most likely not just the best in Friuli but perhaps in Italy.
